The advanced, affordable D-EYE Vet retinal examiner is a phone-case-sized add-on that turns an iPhone or Android smartphone into an ophthalmoscope-camera capable of recording and transmitting video and still images of the eye for screening and evaluating the vision health of pets, small animals, horses, birds and other species. Completely portable, lightweight and noiseless, the D-EYE Vet is easy to use with animals of nearly all sizes and in all settings.

Nearly all animal fundus diseases or lesions can be identified with the D-EYE Vet, including retinal hemorrhage, retinal detachment, retinal atrophy, retinal dyplasia, choroidal hypoplasia, optic disc coloboma and more. A D-EYE software app installed on the smartphone provides step-by-step instructions and archives all examinations for convenient file management, allowing doctors to share those images with clients for better understanding of the causes and effects of treatment.
